



Q: Is Riviera Nayarit a safe place to visit?

A: Riviera Nayarit's tourism grew 5% in the last year, welcoming 3 million visitors and there have been no local incidents involving our tourists or population.

Q: What is Riviera Nayarit doing to safeguard the security of its guests?

A: Riviera Nayarit is dedicated to ensuring the protection and security of its visitors. Riviera Nayarit and its hotels work closely together to assure the safety of its guests 24/7 in a highly vigilant yet discreet manner. Riviera Nayarit has a team of dedicated Tourism Police to support and protect its visitors. The Tourism Police are always on hand to respond to visitor questions while patrolling the beaches, towns and highways. Moreover, they are part of a larger security network and are in constant communication with State and Federal Police. Each resort also has security personnel who check arriving guests and their visitors, as well as monitoring the beaches and allowing access to the resort for guests.
